ensure social fairness




build our resilience



HOW? – OBJECTIVES

By 2025:

- 50% of adults take part in learning
- 30% of low-qualified adults take part in learning
- 20% of unemployed people with a recent learning experience
- 70% of adults have at least basic digital skills




New European Skills Agenda 2020
